OFCCP

COVID-19 Emergency Audit Extensions

- Up to 90 day for desk audit submission
- Information response extensions liberally granted (thanks!)

Scheduling Letter FAQ Changes

- "Semi-automatic" 30-day extension for itemized listing materials
- Monitoring period production limited to 6 months of data
- Return to prior response options for audits received in "11th month" of plan year

Transparency

 OFCCP will provide contractors with informal statement of audit indicators or other problem areas for voluntary discussion and possible resolution <u>before</u> issuance of PDN



Making a Difference (cont.)

OFCCP

- Compensation Roundtable increased alignment between expert opinions and OFCCP practices
- New and updated scheduling letters address contractors' concerns outlined in NILG comments
- OFCCP signals no annual plan upload in upcoming verification procedure
- Final rule on Tricare adopts NILG comment argument and language
- Input for anticipated "promotions focused reviews" and "certainty directive"



NILG Statement on Recent Events

As an organization committed to equal employment opportunity and equitable treatment in the workplace, we would like to take a moment to reflect on the pain of social injustice towards Black Americans.
